Year 8 English have been reading the novel Walking the Boundaries. In groups the students brought different scenes of the novel to life.


























STAGE 6 PDHPE

 GO TO-> the <u>NHS OLIVER LIBRARY HOMEPAGE</u>, logged in under your STUDENT/STAFF PORTAL, and search as you would normally for a book of your choice, clicking on the BORROW button when you find an eBook you wish to Borrow.

NB. You can also use the Other Searches <u>TAB</u> -> Lists -> and look at the Wheelers <u>ePlatform</u> Reading List to see ALL the eBooks available.

NB. TO READ your book - > Go to -> Current Loans-> Electronic Loans -> OPEN the book @ Title OR the VIEW Icon

Go TO -> the Wheelers Platform site for NHS -> ie. URL (Google it)

and log in using your **DET USERNAME** and **DET PASSWORD** and begin borrowing.

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
